Highlights;

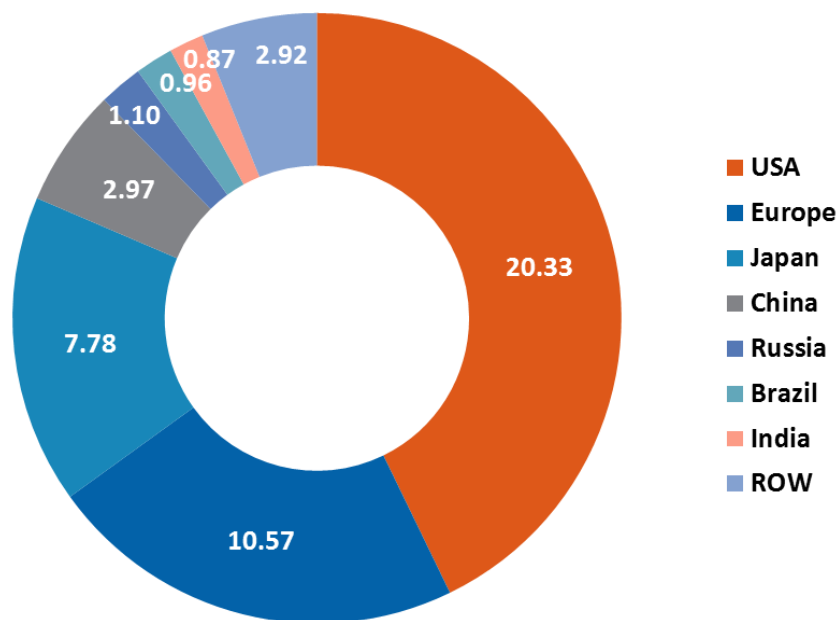
The global market for and emergency medical service equipment & ambulance in 2012 was \$5.8 billion and reached \$5.9 billion in 2013.

At a 2.9% compound annual growth rate (CAGR) from 2013 to 2019, this market is expected to rise to \$6.8 billion in 2019.

Infection control, as a segment, is projected to increase from \$2.7 billion in 2013 to \$3.3 billion by 2018, with a CAGR of 3.8% for the period of 2013 to 2019.

Cardiac and respiratory, as a segment, is projected to increase from \$2.4 billion in 2013 to \$2.7 billion by 2018, with a CAGR of 2.2% for the period of 2013 to 2019.

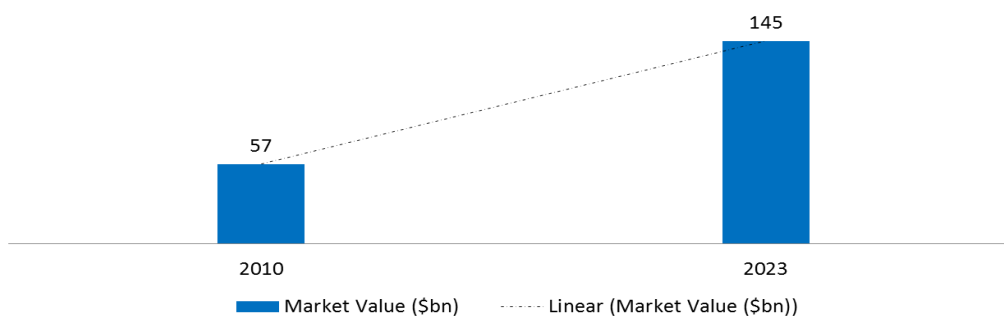
